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8 SYNOPSIS: This bill makes an appropriation of
9 \$150,000 from the State General Fund to the Total
10 Alternative to Street Crime (TASC) Program for the
11 support and operations of the program for the
12 fiscal year ending September 30, 2010, provides
13 that the appropriation is subject to certain
14 provisions of the Code of Alabama 1975, requires an
15 operations plan and an audited financial statement
16 prior to the release of any funds, and requires
17 quarterly and end of year performance reports.

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19 A BILL
20 TO BE ENTITLED
21 AN ACT

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23 To make an appropriation of \$150,000 from the State
24 General Fund to the Total Alternative to Street Crime (TASC)
25 Program for the support and operations of the program for the
26 fiscal year ending September 30, 2010, to provide that the
27 appropriation is subject to certain provisions of the Code of

1 Alabama 1975, to require an operations plan and an audited
2 financial statement prior to the release of any funds, and to
3 require quarterly and end of year performance reports.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

5 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated the sum of
6 \$150,000 from the State General Fund to the Total Alternative
7 to Street Crime (TASC) Program for the support and operations
8 of the program for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2010.

9 Section 2. The above appropriation shall be subject
10 to the provisions, terms, conditions, and limitations of the
11 Budget and Financial Control Act, Code of Alabama 1975,
12 Sections 41-4-80 et seq.; the provisions of The Budget
13 Management Act of 1976, Code of Alabama 1975, Sections 41-19-1
14 et seq.; and any other provisions of this act.

15 Section 3. (a) Prior to the release of any funds
16 appropriated under this act the following reports shall be
17 submitted:

18 (1) An operations plan for the remainder of the
19 fiscal year 2009-2010, including goals and measurable
20 performance indicators, shall be submitted to and approved by
21 the Director of Finance, as provided for state agencies in
22 Code of Alabama 1975, Section 41-19-10.

23 (2) An audited financial statement for all
24 operations during the fiscal year 2008-2009.

25 (b) It is the intent of the Legislature that funds
26 appropriated for fiscal year 2009-2010 shall be released by

1 the Director of Finance following receipt of the above
2 reports.

3 (c) In addition, quarterly reports for fiscal year
4 2009-2010 shall be made to the Director of Finance relating
5 actual expenditures and accomplishments to planned
6 expenditures and accomplishments. An end of year performance
7 report for the fiscal year 2009-2010 shall be made to the
8 Director of Finance stating the work accomplished and the
9 services provided and the costs of accomplishing the work and
10 providing the services, citing meaningful measures of program
11 effectiveness and costs, as is required for state agencies in
12 Code of Alabama 1975, Section 41-19-11.

13 (d) The Director of Finance shall forward a copy of
14 all required reports to the Joint Fiscal Committee in a timely
15 manner.

16 Section 4. This act shall become effective
17 immediately following its passage and approval by the
18 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
