17	agency of a motor vehicle accident.
18	(2) ENTITY. A governmental entity or agency or
19	department of a governmental entity.
20	(3) LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY. The Alabama Department
21	of Public Safety, the police department of each incorporated
22	city or municipality, the department of each sheriff of the
23	state, including all deputies sheriff deputy sheriffs, the
24	enforcement division of the Department of Conservation and
25	Natural Resources, and the Public Service Commission, and each
26	public agency in the state charged with the enforcement of any

laws and the officers and employees of which have the power as such to make arrests. The term shall_does not include rescue squads or volunteer fire departments.

4 (4) LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER. An officer of a law enforcement agency.

Section 2. Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, no law enforcement agency, law enforcement officer, or other entity shall impose an accident response service fee on or from an insurance company, the driver or owner of a motor vehicle, or any other person or entity.

Section 3. This act shall become effective immediately following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
