9 A BILL
10 TO BE ENTITLED
11 AN ACT
12

13 To alter, rearrange, and extend the boundary lines
14 and corporate limits of the Town of Gilberttown in Choctaw
15 County; and to provide for a referendum on this act.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

17 Section 1. The boundary lines and corporate limits
18 of the Town of Gilberttown in Choctaw County are altered,
19 rearranged, and extended to include within the corporate
20 limits of the municipality, in addition to the lands now
21 included, all of the following territory:

22 Beginning at the Northwest corner of Section 31,
23 Township 11 North, Range 3 West; thence run due East along
24 section lines to the Northeast corner of Section 33, Township
25 11 North, Range 3 West; thence run due South along section
26 line to the Southeast corner of Section 9, Township 10 North,
27 Range 3 West; thence run due West along section line to the

1 Southwest corner of Section 8, Township 10 North, Range 3
2 West; thence run due South to the Southeast corner of Section
3 18, Township 10 North, Range 3 West; thence run due West along
4 section line to the Southwest corner Section 18, Township 10
5 North, Range 3 West; thence run due North, along section line
6 to the Southwest corner of Section 31, Township 11 North,
7 Range 3 West; thence run due West along section line to the
8 Southwest corner of Section 36, Township 11 North, Range 4
9 West; thence run due North along the section line to the
10 Northwest corner of Section 36, Township 11 North, Range 4
11 West; thence run due East along section line to the Northwest
12 corner of Section 31, Township 11 North, Range 4 West to Point
13 of Beginning.

14 The above described land containing in all 7,040
15 acres more or less. All of said parcel lying and being in
16 Choctaw County, Alabama.

17 Section 2. In accordance with Section 11-42-6(b) of
18 the Code of Alabama 1975, a map showing what territory is
19 proposed to be annexed to the Town of Gilberttown is on file in
20 the office of the Judge of Probate in Choctaw County, Alabama,
21 and the map is open to the inspection of the public.

22 Section 3. Section 1 of this act shall become
23 operative only if approved by the qualified electors who
24 reside within the territory described in Section 1 who vote in
25 a referendum election to be held on the date of the 2012
26 Gilberttown municipal election. The notice of the election
27 shall be given by the Judge of Probate of Choctaw County, and

1 the elections shall be held, conducted, and the results
2 canvassed in conjunction with the Gilbertown municipal
3 election on August 28, 2012. The question shall be, "Do you
4 favor the adoption of Act No. ___ of the ___ Session of the
5 Alabama Legislature which alters, rearranges, and extends the
6 corporate limits of the Town of Gilbertown in Choctaw County?
7 Yes () No ()." The Town of Gilbertown shall pay any costs
8 and expenses incidental to the election. If a majority of the
9 votes cast in the election are "Yes," Section 1 of this act
10 shall become operative immediately. If the majority of the
11 votes are "No," this act shall be repealed and shall have no
12 further effect.

13 Section 4. This act shall become effective on the
14 first day of the third month following its passage and
15 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
