8 SYNOPSIS: Under existing law, a law enforcement  
9 officer must complete certification by the Peace  
10 Officers' Standards and Training Commission, but  
11 there is no requirement that a law enforcement  
12 officer complete deadly force recertification each  
13 year.

14 This bill would require annual  
15 recertification of law enforcement officers  
16 regarding the use of deadly force and would require  
17 the Peace Officers' Standards and Training  
18 Commission to develop a relevant training course.

21 TO BE ENTITLED  
22 AN ACT

24 To require annual recertification of law enforcement  
25 officers regarding the use of deadly force; to provide for  
26 development of a training course by the Peace Officers'  
27 Standards and Training Commission.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

2 Section 1. (a) Every local and state law enforcement  
3 agency shall provide annual recertification training relating  
4 to the use of deadly force for each law enforcement officer,  
5 as defined by Section 36-21-40, Code of Alabama 1975, employed  
6 by the agency.

7 (b) The Alabama Peace Officers' Standards and  
8 Training Commission shall approve a training course that  
9 satisfies the requirements of this section.

10 Section 2. This act shall become effective on the  
11 first day of the third month following its passage and  
12 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
