4 ENROLLED, An Act,

5 Providing for an annual appropriation from the  
6 Education Trust Fund to each public state earned classroom  
7 teacher in public school grades K to 12 in the sum of \$300 for  
8 classroom supplies; and providing for the promulgation of  
9 rules.

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

11 Section 1. (a) There shall be annually appropriated  
12 from the Education Trust Fund to each public state earned  
13 classroom teacher in public school grades K to 12 the sum of  
14 three hundred dollars (\$300) for classroom supplies.

15 (b) Classroom supplies may include, but are not  
16 limited to, paper goods, cleaning supplies, hand soap and  
17 cleaner, pencils, pens, paper, and similar general supplies  
18 utilized on a regular basis in the classroom.

19 (c) The State Superintendent of Education may  
20 promulgate rules in conformity with this section regarding  
21 implementation of the requirements of this section. Such rules  
22 shall include, but are not limited to, a simple and minimal  
23 paper work method for teachers to account for the expenditure  
24 of such funds.

1                   Section 2. This act shall become effective on the  
2 first day of the third month following its passage and  
3 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
