20	Section 1. (a) In Elmore County, a booking fee in
21	the amount of twenty-five dollars (\$25) shall be assessed by
22	the clerk of the court as court costs against each defendant
23	incarcerated in or booked in the Elmore County Jail if the
24	defendant is convicted or pleads guilty in cases prosecuted in
25	the circuit court or district court of the county.
26	(b) The clerk of the court shall enter the booking

fee on the docket sheet and collect the fee in the same manner

and at the same time as other court costs are collected. The
booking fee assessed pursuant to this act shall be in addition
to all other fines, court costs, or other charges now or
hereafter provided by law. The court costs provided by this
act shall not be waived by any court unless all other fees,
assessments, costs, fines, and charges associated with the

case are waived.

(c) The clerk of the court shall remit the booking fees collected pursuant to this act on a monthly basis to the Elmore County Commission to be deposited in the county general fund to be used for the operation of the Sheriff's Office to provide additional motor vehicles and information technology equipment and for other law enforcement purposes.

Section 2. This act shall become effective on the first day of the third month following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
