8 SYNOPSIS: Under existing law, a county superintendent
9 of education may be elected if authorized under a
10 local law or amendment to the Constitution of
11 Alabama of 1901.

12 This bill would require all county
13 superintendents to be appointed by the county board
14 of education, except as otherwise provided by the
15 Constitution of Alabama of 1901.

21 Relating to county superintendents of education; to
22 require all county superintendents to be appointed by the
23 county board of education, except as otherwise provided by the
24 Constitution of Alabama of 1901.

25 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

1 Section 1. (a) Except as otherwise provided by the
2 Constitution of Alabama of 1901, a county superintendent of
3 education shall be appointed by the county board of education.

4 (b) This section shall apply at the expiration of
5 the term of office of any elected county superintendent of
6 education or upon a vacancy occurring in the office of an
7 elected county superintendent of education occurring before
8 the expiration of his or her term of office.

9 Section 2. All laws or parts of laws which conflict
10 with this act are repealed.

11 Section 3. This act shall become effective
12 immediately following its passage and approval by the
13 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
