13 Relating to Perry County; authorizing the county
14 commission to levy an additional ad valorem tax and providing
15 for a referendum.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

17 Section 1. Pursuant to subsection (f) of Amendment
18 No. 373 to the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, the Perry
19 County Commission may levy, in addition to any other tax, an
20 ad valorem tax in the amount of three mills on each dollar of
21 taxable property in the county. The revenue from the
22 additional tax shall be paid to the county general fund and
23 distributed to the Perry County Hospital Board for ambulance
24 service and general health and welfare for the county.

25 Section 2. The increase in the rate of the tax as
26 provided by this act is subject to the approval of a majority
27 of the qualified electors of the county who vote on the

1 proposed increase in a special election which shall be held on
2 the first Tuesday in September 2015, after the county has
3 conducted a public hearing for public comment on the proposed
4 increase in the ad valorem tax. Notification of the public
5 hearing shall be advertised, or notice given, in a newspaper
6 of general circulation in the county at least 30 days before
7 the hearing.

8 Section 3. This act shall become effective
9 immediately following its passage and approval by the
10 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
