ENROLLED, House Joint Resolution,
NAMING THE ISLAND IN THE CITY OF GUNTERSVILLE NORTH
OF THE PENINSULA DIRECTLY CONNECTED BY THE VETERAN'S BRIDGE
"LAKESHORE ISLAND."

WHEREAS, there is currently an unnamed island in the
City of Guntersville north of the peninsula directly connected
by the Veteran's Bridge; and

WHEREAS, this island was the site of the Lakeshore
Motel from the 1940's to the 1960's; and

WHEREAS, the residents of the island desire to name
this area "Lakeshore Island"; and

WHEREAS, the City of Guntersville, the Marshall
County Commission, and the Guntersville Historical Society are
all in agreement with naming the island "Lakeshore Island";
and

WHEREAS, the State Department of Transportation has
requested that the Legislature designate the island prior to
the placement of signs recognizing Lakeshore Island; now
therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH
HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That the island in the City of
Guntersville north of the peninsula directly connected by the
Veteran's Bridge on U.S. 431 is hereby named "Lakeshore
