8 SYNOPSIS: Under existing law, the State Superintendent
9 of Education is appointed by and serves at the
10 pleasure of the State Board of Education.

11 This bill would propose an amendment to
12 Amendment No. 284 to the Constitution of Alabama of
13 1901, relating to the selection, qualifications,
14 powers, duties, and tenure of the State
15 Superintendent of Education; to provide for the
16 election of the State Superintendent of Education
17 by the qualified electors of the state.

23 To propose an amendment to Amendment No. 284 to the
24 Constitution of Alabama of 1901, now appearing as Section 264
25 of the Official Recompilation of the Constitution of Alabama
26 of 1901, as amended, relating to the selection,
27 qualifications, powers, duties, and tenure of the State

1 Superintendent of Education; to provide for the election of
2 the State Superintendent of Education by the qualified
3 electors of the state.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

5 Section 1. The following amendment to the
6 Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended, is proposed and
7 shall become valid as a part thereof when approved by a
8 majority of the qualified electors voting thereon and in
9 accordance with Sections 284, 285, and 287 of the Constitution
10 of Alabama of 1901, as amended:

11 PROPOSED AMENDMENT

12 "Amendment No. 284.

13 "1. General supervision of the public schools in
14 Alabama shall be vested in a ~~state board of education~~ State
15 Board of Education, which shall be elected in such manner as
16 the ~~legislature~~ Legislature may provide.

17 "2. The chief state school officer shall be the
18 ~~state superintendent of education, who shall be appointed by~~
19 ~~the state board of education and serve at its pleasure~~ State
20 Superintendent of Education. The State Superintendent of
21 Education shall be elected by the qualified electors of the
22 state at the same time and in the same manner as provided for
23 the election of other elected state officers in the year 2018
24 and every fourth year thereafter. The authority and duties of
25 the ~~superintendent of education~~ Superintendent of Education
26 shall be determined by the ~~state board of education~~ according
27 to such regulations as the legislature may prescribe

1 ~~Legislature.~~ The ~~superintendent of education~~ Superintendent of
2 Education shall receive an annual salary ~~which shall be fixed~~
3 ~~by the legislature of Alabama and shall be paid from the state~~
4 ~~treasury in installments as the salaries of other state~~
5 ~~officers are paid~~ to be determined by the Governor and in an
6 amount not less than the salary payable to the Superintendent
7 of Education on November 1, 2016.

8 "3. The ~~legislature~~ Legislature shall enact
9 appropriate laws to implement or enforce this ~~article of~~
10 amendment.

11 "4. The provisions of ~~article~~ Article V and Article
12 XIV of the Constitution of Alabama as amended in conflict with
13 this article are expressly repealed. ~~However, this amendment~~
14 ~~shall not be so construed as to effect the election or term of~~
15 ~~the state superintendent of education chosen before it becomes~~
16 ~~valid as a part of the Constitution."~~

17 Section 2. An election upon the proposed amendment
18 shall be held in accordance with Sections 284 and 285 of the
19 Constitution of Alabama of 1901, now appearing as Sections 284
20 and 285 of the Official Recompilation of the Constitution of
21 Alabama of 1901, as amended, and the election laws of this
22 state.

23 Section 3. The appropriate election official shall
24 assign a ballot number for the proposed constitutional
25 amendment on the election ballot and shall set forth the
26 following description of the substance or subject matter of
27 the proposed constitutional amendment:

1 "Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of
2 Alabama of 1901, to provide for the election of the State
3 Superintendent of Education by the qualified voters of the
4 state.

5 "Proposed by Act _____."

6 This description shall be followed by the following
7 language:

8 "Yes () No ()."
