8 SYNOPSIS: This bill would authorize the county
9 commission of a county or the municipal governing
10 body of a municipality where the Sunday sale of
11 alcoholic beverages is authorized to extend the
12 time of sale to commence at 10:00 a.m. on Sundays
13 for on-premises consumption as provided by
14 ordinance or resolution of the county or the
15 municipal governing body.

21 Relating to alcoholic beverages; to authorize the
22 county commission of a county or the municipal governing body
23 of a municipality where the Sunday sale of alcoholic beverages
24 is otherwise authorized by law to extend the time of sale of
25 alcoholic beverages on Sunday for on-premise consumption.
26 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

1 Section 1. In any county or municipality where the
2 Sunday sale of alcoholic beverages is otherwise authorized by
3 law, including the sale for on-premises consumption at a time
4 after 10:00 a.m., the sale of alcoholic beverages on Sunday
5 may be authorized for on-premises consumption commencing on
6 Sunday at 10:00 a.m., and thereafter, by the county commission
7 outside of the corporate limits of any municipality or the
8 municipal governing body within the corporate limits of a
9 municipality by ordinance or by resolution of the appropriate
10 governing body.

11 Section 2. The provisions of this act are
12 supplemental and shall not be construed to repeal any other
13 law except to the extent of any conflict.

14 Section 3. This act shall become effective
15 immediately following its passage and approval by the
16 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
