19	emergency-related information to be compiled in one central
20	electronic repository that is accessible by the department and
21	the Governor.
22	(b) The department shall implement the electronic
23	notification system under subsection (a) by October 1, 2017.
24	(c) It is the intent of the Legislature that all
25	local schools and local school systems use the electronic
26	notification system implemented by the department as a means
27	of relaying information as set forth in subsection (a).

Section 2. This act shall become effective on the first day of the third month following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
