4 ENROLLED, An Act,

5 Relating to nondriver identification cards and  
6 parolees; to give the Secretary of the Alabama State Law  
7 Enforcement Agency, in coordination with the Commissioner of  
8 the Department of Corrections, the authority to establish a  
9 program to issue a nondriver identification card to a resident  
10 parolee upon his or her release from prison.

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

12 Section 1. The Secretary of the Alabama State Law  
13 Enforcement Agency, in coordination with the Commissioner of  
14 the Department of Corrections, shall have the authority to  
15 promulgate rules to establish a program by January 1 of the  
16 year following the effective date of this act to issue a  
17 nondriver identification card to a resident upon his or her  
18 release from the Department of Corrections.

19 Section 2. This act shall become effective on the  
20 first day of the third month following its passage and  
21 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
