5 To amend Section 16-1-25 of the Code of Alabama  
6 1975, allow military recruiters of the United States Armed  
7 Forces and United States Department of Homeland Security the  
8 same access to students and campus facilities that the  
9 institution grants to prospective employers or to  
10 postsecondary institutions.

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

12 Section 1. Section 16-1-25 of the Code of Alabama  
13 1975, is amended to read as follows:

14 "§16-1-25.

15 "All city and county public school systems and all  
16 public institutions of higher education as defined by Section  
17 16-5-1 and all divisions of public institutions of higher  
18 education shall ~~allow reasonable access of their facilities to~~  
19 ~~official recruiting representatives of branches of the armed~~  
20 ~~forces and military forces of the United States, consistent~~  
21 ~~with policies governing other agencies not a part of the~~  
22 ~~school system or institution of higher education, to inform~~  
23 ~~students of the educational and occupational options in~~  
24 ~~military service.~~ grant military recruiters of the United  
25 States Armed Forces and United States Department of Homeland

1     Security the same information and access to students and  
2     campus facilities as the institution grants to prospective  
3     employers of students or to postsecondary institutions."

4             Section 2. This act shall become effective on the  
5     first day of the third month following its passage and  
6     approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
