5 Relating to extradition; to amend Section 15-9-34,
6 Code of Alabama 1975; to authorize extradition of a person to
7 another state if the person has been charged, whether by
8 indictment or by other criminal procedure, in the other state
9 for committing an act resulting in a crime in that state.

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

11 Section 1. Section 15-9-34, Code of Alabama 1975, is
12 amended to read as follows:

13 "§15-9-34.

14 "On demand of the executive authority of any other
15 state, the Governor of this state may also surrender any
16 person in this state charged ~~on indictment found in such the~~
17 other state in the manner provided in Section 15-9-31 with
18 committing an act ~~in this state~~ intentionally resulting in a
19 crime in ~~such the~~ other state, and the provisions of this
20 division not otherwise inconsistent shall apply in such cases,
21 notwithstanding that the accused was not in that state at the
22 time of the commission of the crime and has not fled ~~therefrom~~
23 from that state."

1 Section 2. This act shall become effective on the
2 first day of the third month following its passage and
3 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
