ENROLLED, An Act,

Relating to alcoholic beverages; to authorize the county commission of a county or the municipal governing body of a municipality where the Sunday sale of alcoholic beverages is otherwise authorized by law to extend the time of sale of alcoholic beverages on Sunday for on-premise consumption; and to provide for certain exceptions.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. In any county or municipality where the Sunday sale of alcoholic beverages is otherwise authorized by law, including the sale for on-premises consumption at a time after 10:00 a.m., the sale of alcoholic beverages on Sunday may be authorized for on-premises consumption commencing on Sunday at 10:00 a.m., and thereafter, by the county commission outside of the corporate limits of any municipality or the municipal governing body within the corporate limits of a municipality by ordinance or by resolution of the appropriate governing body.

~~Section 2. This act shall not apply to any county or municipality that has previously held a vote of the people to establish parameters around the sale of alcoholic beverages on Sunday.~~

(a) This act shall not apply to any county or municipality where the sale of alcoholic beverages on Sunday

1 was authorized by a local law setting a later time for the
2 sale of alcoholic beverages on Sunday and the local law was
3 subject to approval at a referendum unless the application of
4 this act to the county or municipality is subsequently
5 approved by a referendum held in the county or municipality.
6 The county or municipal governing body may set the referendum
7 by ordinance or resolution in conjunction with any other
8 countywide or municipal election as the case may be.

9 (b) This act shall not affect the authority of the
10 Legislature by local law to extend the time of Sunday sales of
11 alcoholic beverages to an earlier time than the time
12 authorized in this act.

13 (c) This act shall not apply in a county where the
14 sale of alcoholic beverages is authorized by a local
15 constitutional amendment.

16 Section 3. The provisions of this act are
17 supplemental and shall not be construed to repeal any other
18 law except to the extent of any conflict.

19 Section 4. This act shall become effective
20 immediately following its passage and approval by the
21 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
