9 applies for or renews a driver's license, vessel
10 license, or nondriver identification card to
11 provide emergency contact information to the
12 Alabama State Law Enforcement Agency.

18 Relating to driver's licenses and similar licenses
19 or cards issued by the Alabama State Law Enforcement Agency;
20 to authorize a person who applies for a driver's license or
21 similar license or card or the renewal of a license or card to
22 provide emergency contact information to the Alabama State Law
23 Enforcement Agency.

24 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

25 Section 1. This act shall be known and may be cited
26 as the Allison Faye Brown Act.

1 Section 2. (a) Beginning January 1 following the
2 effective date of this act, each person who applies for a new
3 driver's license, nondriver identification card, or vessel
4 license, or a learner's license or permit, or the renewal of
5 any of these licenses, cards, or permits, may provide the
6 Alabama State Law Enforcement Agency with the name and contact
7 information for the contact of a person in the event of an
8 emergency. The emergency contact information provided in this
9 section shall be stored in the records of the agency and made
10 available to law enforcement personnel for contact in the
11 event law enforcement deems contact is in the best interest of
12 the licensee or card holder.

13 (b) The Alabama State Law Enforcement Agency may
14 adopt rules necessary to carry out this act.

15 Section 3. This act shall become effective
16 immediately following its passage and approval by the
17 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
