8 SYNOPSIS: This bill would require the state, a county,
9 a municipality, or a local board of education to
10 sell to the highest bidder at public auction or
11 transfer to the Alabama Land Bank Authority any
12 building owned by the state, county, municipality,
13 or local board of education that is unused and has
14 been uninhabited for not less than two years.

20 Relating to public property; to provide for the
21 disposal of certain public buildings, with exceptions.

22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

23 Section 1. (a) Except as provided in subsection (b),
24 a building owned by the state, a county, a municipality, or a
25 local board of education that is unused and has been
26 uninhabited for not less than two years shall be either sold

1 to the highest bidder at a public auction or transferred to
2 the Alabama Land Bank Authority.

3 (b) This section does not apply to any state-owned
4 university, trade school, or community college.

5 Section 2. This act shall become effective on the
6 first day of the third month following its passage and
7 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
