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2 ENROLLED, House Joint Resolution,
3 NAMING A PORTION OF STATE HIGHWAY 77 IN CALHOUN
4 COUNTY, THE TRACY SANDERS MEMORIAL HIGHWAY.
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6 WHEREAS, Tracy Sanders was a lifelong resident of
7 the Mount Olive Community and joined the Mount Olive Volunteer
8 Fire Department in 2006; and

9 WHEREAS, Tracy Sanders became Chief of the Mount
10 Olive Volunteer Fire Department in 2011; and

11 WHEREAS, on January 13, 2017, Tracy Sanders was
12 killed in the line-of-duty while driving the Mount Olive
13 Volunteer Fire Department rescue truck on State Highway 77
14 near Ohatchee when the rescue truck was struck from behind
15 resulting in her death; and

16 WHEREAS, Tracy Sanders is survived by her husband of
17 20 years, Randall Sanders, two daughters, Shelby and Raegan,
18 and one grandchild, Baila;

19 WHEREAS, this body desires to make a special
20 designation in memory of her life and service to her
21 community; now therefore,

22 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH
23 HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That to honor the life and memory
24 of Tracy Sanders, we declare that a portion of State Highway
25 77 from the Talladega County/Calhoun County line near mile

1 marker 82 to its intersection with State Highway 144 near mile
2 marker 91, be named the Tracy Sanders Memorial Highway.

3 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That appropriate officials
4 are requested to place and maintain signs or markers as
5 provided in this resolution.
