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8 NAMING A PORTION OF STATE HIGHWAY 77 IN CALHOUN
9 COUNTY, THE TRACY SANDERS MEMORIAL HIGHWAY.

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11 WHEREAS, Tracy Sanders was a lifelong resident of
12 the Mount Olive Community and joined the Mount Olive Volunteer
13 Fire Department in 2006; and

14 WHEREAS, Tracy Sanders became Chief of the Mount
15 Olive Volunteer Fire Department in 2011; and

16 WHEREAS, on January 13, 2017, Tracy Sanders was
17 killed in the line-of-duty while driving the Mount Olive
18 Volunteer Fire Department rescue truck on State Highway 77
19 near Ohatchee when the rescue truck was struck from behind
20 resulting in her death; and

21 WHEREAS, Tracy Sanders is survived by her husband of
22 20 years, Randall Sanders, two daughters, Shelby and Raegan,
23 and one grandchild, Baila;

24 WHEREAS, this body desires to make a special
25 designation in memory of her life and service to her
26 community; now therefore,

1 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH
2 HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That to honor the life and memory
3 of Tracy Sanders, we declare that a portion of State Highway
4 77 from the Talladega County/Calhoun County line near mile
5 marker 82 to its intersection with State Highway 144 near mile
6 marker 91, be named the Tracy Sanders Memorial Highway.

7 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That appropriate officials
8 are requested to place and maintain signs or markers as
9 provided in this resolution.
