12 years of age, and we uplift his inspiring life and legacy with

23 Medicine in Alabama and Mississippi with special training in  
24 Pulmonary Medicine and was a member of the Mobile Medical

2           champion boxer; he demonstrated abundant love and compassion  
3           to everyone in his life; and

4           WHEREAS, survivors include his beloved and devoted  
5           wife, Elaine Novak Ahmadi; children, Alicia Grace Ahmadi, Mark  
6           Patrick Ahmadi, and Thomas Andrew Ahmadi; and grandchildren,  
7           Matthew Brandon Ahmadi, Mark Patrick Ahmadi, and Paulina Grace  
8           Ahmadi; and many extended family members; he was preceded in  
9           death by his parents, Ali and Parvine Ahmadi; first wife,  
10          Nettie Catherine Arata Ahmadi; sons, Timothy Peter Ahmadi and  
11          Gregory Joseph Ahmadi; brother, Manu Ahmadi; and sister,
