4 ENROLLED, An Act,

5 Relating to public education; to require a public
6 school district or any employee of a public school district to
7 grant all professional educators' associations the same level
8 of access to employees of the public school district.

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

10 Section 1. (a) A public school district or any
11 employee of a public school district shall grant all
12 professional educators' associations the same level of access
13 to employees of the public school district. No professional
14 educators' association shall have a level of access to
15 employees of the public school district that is greater than
16 or less than any other professional educators' association.

17 (b) For purposes of this section, access shall
18 include, but is not limited to, all of the following:

19 (1) Setting up informational tables at inservice or
20 other similar meetings.

21 (2) Speaking at inservice or other similar meetings.

22 (3) Distributing information in a school's mail
23 boxes or through a school's email system.

24 (4) Utilizing a school's meeting rooms during
25 nonworking hours.

1 (5) Representing employees in employment matters,
2 when requested by the employee.

3 (6) Posting information on school bulletin boards.

4 Section 2. This act shall become effective
5 immediately upon its passage and approval by the Governor, or
6 its otherwise becoming law.
