11 Relating to Schedule I controlled substances; to
12 amend Sections 13A-12-211, 13A-12-231, Code of Alabama 1975,
13 to provide enhanced criminal penalties for the unlawful
14 possession or unlawful distribution, Fentanyl, and certain
15 synthetic controlled substance analogues; to provide criminal
16 penalties for the unlawful trafficking of Fentanyl or any
17 synthetic controlled substance Fentanyl analogue added to
18 Schedule I; to provide an alternative method for charging a
19 person for trafficking of certain controlled substances or
20 analogues; to amend Section 20-2-23, Code of Alabama 1975, to
21 add certain named chemical compounds of Fentanyl and synthetic
22 controlled substance Fentanyl analogues, to Schedule I of the
23 controlled substances list; and in connection therewith would
24 have as its purpose or effect the requirement of a new or
25 increased expenditure of local funds within the meaning of
26 Amendment 621 of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, now

1 appearing as Section 111.05 of the Official Recompilation of
2 the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

4 Section 1. Sections 13A-12-211, 13A-12-231, and
5 Section 20-2-23, Code of Alabama 1975, are amended to read as
6 follows:

7 "§13A-12-211.

8 "(a) A person commits the crime of unlawful
9 distribution of controlled substances if, except as otherwise
10 authorized, he or she sells, furnishes, gives away, delivers,
11 or distributes a controlled substance enumerated in Schedules
12 I through V.

13 "(b) Unlawful distribution of controlled substances
14 is a Class B felony.

15 "(c) A person commits the crime of unlawful
16 possession with intent to distribute a controlled substance
17 if, except as otherwise authorized by law, he or she knowingly
18 possesses any of the following quantities of a controlled
19 substance:

20 "(1) More than eight grams, but less than 28 grams,
21 of cocaine or of any mixture containing cocaine.

22 "(2) More than two grams, but less than four grams,
23 of any morphine, opium, or any salt, isomer, or salt of an
24 isomer thereof, including heroin.

25 "(3) More than eight grams, but less than 28 grams,
26 of 3,4-methylenedioxy amphetamine, or of any mixture
27 containing 3,4-methylenedioxy amphetamine.

1 "(4) More than eight grams, but less than 28 grams,
2 of 5-methoxy-3, 4-methylenedioxy amphetamine, or of any
3 mixture containing 5-methoxy-3, 4-methylenedioxy amphetamine.

4 "(5) More than eight grams, but less than 28 grams,
5 of amphetamine or any mixture containing amphetamine, its
6 salt, optical isomer, or salt of its optical isomer thereof.

7 "(6) More than eight grams, but less than 28 grams,
8 of methamphetamine or any mixture containing methamphetamine,
9 its salts, optical isomers, or salt of its optical isomers
10 thereof.

11 "(7) More than one-half gram, but less than one
12 gram, of Fentanyl or any synthetic controlled substance
13 Fentanyl analogue, or any mixture containing Fentanyl or any
14 synthetic controlled substance Fentanyl analogue.

15 "(d) Unlawful possession with intent to distribute a
16 controlled substance is a Class B felony.

17 "§13A-12-231.

18 "Except as authorized in Chapter 2, Title 20:

19 "(1) Any person who knowingly sells, manufactures,
20 delivers, or brings into this state, or who is knowingly in
21 actual or constructive possession of, in excess of one kilo or
22 2.2 pounds of any part of the plant of the genus Cannabis,
23 whether growing or not, the seeds thereof, the resin extracted
24 from any part of the plant, and every compound, manufacture,
25 salt, derivative, mixture, or preparation of the plant, its
26 seeds, or resin including the completely defoliated mature
27 stalks of the plant, fiber produced from the stalks, oil, or

1 cake, or the completely sterilized samples of seeds of the
2 plant which are incapable of germination is guilty of a
3 felony, which felony shall be known as "trafficking in
4 cannabis." Nothing in this subdivision shall apply to samples
5 of tetrahydrocannabinols including, but not limited to, all
6 synthetic or naturally produced samples of
7 tetrahydrocannabinols which contain more than 15 percent by
8 weight of tetrahydrocannabinols and which do not contain plant
9 material exhibiting the external morphological features of the
10 plant cannabis. If the quantity of cannabis involved:

11 "a. Is in excess of one kilo or 2.2 pounds, but less
12 than 100 pounds, the person shall be sentenced to a mandatory
13 minimum term of imprisonment of three calendar years and to
14 pay a fine of twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000).

15 "b. Is 100 pounds or more, but less than 500 pounds,
16 the person shall be sentenced to a mandatory minimum term of
17 imprisonment of five calendar years and to pay a fine of fifty
18 thousand dollars (\$50,000).

19 "c. Is 500 pounds or more, but less than 1,000
20 pounds, the person shall be sentenced to a mandatory minimum
21 term of imprisonment of 15 calendar years and to pay a fine of
22 two hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000).

23 "d. Is 1,000 pounds or more, the person shall be
24 sentenced to a mandatory term of imprisonment of life ~~without~~
25 ~~parole~~.

26 "(2) Any person who knowingly sells, manufactures,
27 delivers, or brings into this state, or who is knowingly in

1 actual or constructive possession of, 28 grams or more of
2 cocaine or of any mixture containing cocaine, described in
3 Section 20-2-25(1), is guilty of a felony, which felony shall
4 be known as "trafficking in cocaine." If the quantity
5 involved:

6 "a. Is 28 grams or more, but less than 500 grams,
7 the person shall be sentenced to a mandatory minimum term of
8 imprisonment of three calendar years and to pay a fine of
9 fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000).

10 "b. Is 500 grams or more, but less than one kilo,
11 the person shall be sentenced to a mandatory minimum term of
12 imprisonment of five calendar years and to pay a fine of one
13 hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000).

14 "c. Is one kilo, but less than 10 kilos, then the
15 person shall be sentenced to a mandatory minimum term of
16 imprisonment of 15 calendar years and to pay a fine of two
17 hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000).

18 "d. Is 10 kilos or more, the person shall be
19 sentenced to a mandatory term of imprisonment of life ~~without~~
20 ~~parole~~.

21 "(3) Any person who knowingly sells, manufactures,
22 delivers, or brings into this state, or who is knowingly in
23 actual or constructive possession of, four grams or more of
24 any morphine, opium, or any salt, isomer, or salt of an isomer
25 thereof, including heroin, as described in Section
26 20-2-23(b) (2) or Section 20-2-25(1)a., or four grams or more
27 of any mixture containing any such substance, is guilty of a

1 felony, which felony shall be known as "trafficking in illegal
2 drugs." If the quantity involved:

3 "a. Is four grams or more, but less than 14 grams,
4 the person shall be sentenced to a mandatory minimum term of
5 imprisonment of three calendar years and to pay a fine of
6 fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000).

7 "b. Is 14 grams or more, but less than 28 grams, the
8 person shall be sentenced to a mandatory minimum term of
9 imprisonment of 10 calendar years and to pay a fine of one
10 hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000).

11 "c. Is 28 grams or more, but less than 56 grams, the
12 person shall be sentenced to a mandatory minimum term of
13 imprisonment of 25 calendar years and to pay a fine of five
14 hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000).

15 "d. Is 56 grams or more, the person shall be
16 sentenced to a mandatory term of imprisonment of life ~~without~~
17 ~~parole~~.

18 "(4) Any person who knowingly sells, manufactures,
19 delivers, or brings into this state, or who is knowingly in
20 actual or constructive possession of 1,000 or more pills or
21 capsules of methaqualone, as described in Section 20-2-1, et
22 seq., is guilty of a felony, which felony shall be known as
23 "trafficking in illegal drugs." If the quantity involved:

24 "a. Is 1,000 pills or capsules, but less than 5,000
25 pills or capsules, the person shall be sentenced to a
26 mandatory minimum term of imprisonment of three calendar years
27 and pay a fine of fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000).

1 "b. Is 5,000 capsules or more, but less than 25,000
2 capsules, that person shall be imprisoned to a mandatory
3 minimum term of imprisonment of 10 calendar years and pay a
4 fine of one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000).

5 "c. Is 25,000 pills or more, but less than 100,000
6 pills or capsules, the person shall be sentenced to a
7 mandatory minimum term of imprisonment of 25 calendar years
8 and pay a fine of five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000).

9 "d. Is 100,000 capsules or more, the person shall be
10 sentenced to a mandatory term of imprisonment of life ~~without~~
11 ~~parole~~.

12 "(5) Any person who knowingly sells, manufactures,
13 delivers or brings into this state, or who is knowingly in
14 actual or constructive possession of 500 or more pills or
15 capsules of hydromorphone as is described in Section 20-2-1,
16 et seq., is guilty of a felony which shall be known as
17 "trafficking in illegal drugs." If the quantity involved:

18 "a. Is 500 pills or capsules or more but less than
19 1,000 pills or capsules, the person shall be sentenced to a
20 mandatory term of imprisonment of three calendar years and to
21 pay a fine of fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000).

22 "b. Is 1,000 pills or capsules or more, but less
23 than 4,000 pills or capsules, the person shall be sentenced to
24 a mandatory term of imprisonment of 10 calendar years and to
25 pay a fine of one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000).

26 "c. Is 4,000 pills or capsules or more but less than
27 10,000 pills or capsules, the person shall be sentenced to a

1 mandatory term of imprisonment of 25 calendar years and to pay
2 a fine of one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000).

3 "d. Is more than 10,000 pills or capsules, the
4 person shall be sentenced to a mandatory term of life ~~in~~
5 ~~prison without parole.~~

6 "(6) Any person who knowingly sells, manufactures,
7 delivers, or brings into this state, or who is knowingly in
8 actual or constructive possession of, 28 grams or more of
9 3,4-methylenedioxy amphetamine, or of any mixture containing
10 3,4-methylenedioxy amphetamine, is guilty of a felony, which
11 felony shall be known as "trafficking in illegal drugs." If
12 the quantity involved:

13 "a. Is 28 grams or more, but less than 500 grams,
14 the person shall be sentenced to a mandatory minimum term of
15 imprisonment of three calendar years and to pay a fine of
16 fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000).

17 "b. Is 500 grams or more, but less than one kilo,
18 the person shall be sentenced to a mandatory minimum term of
19 imprisonment of five calendar years and to pay a fine of one
20 hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000).

21 "c. Is one kilo, but less than 10 kilos, then the
22 person shall be sentenced to a mandatory minimum term of
23 imprisonment of 15 calendar years and to pay a fine of two
24 hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000).

25 "d. Is 10 kilos or more, the person shall be
26 sentenced to a mandatory term of imprisonment of life ~~without~~
27 ~~parole.~~

1 "(7) Any person who knowingly sells, manufactures,
2 delivers, or brings into this state, or who is knowingly in
3 actual or constructive possession of, 28 grams or more of
4 5-methoxy-3, 4-methylenedioxy amphetamine, or of any mixture
5 containing 5-methoxy-3, 4-methylenedioxy amphetamine is guilty
6 of a felony, which felony shall be known as "trafficking in
7 illegal drugs" if the quantity involved:

8 "a. Is 28 grams or more, but less than 500 grams,
9 the person shall be sentenced to a mandatory minimum term of
10 imprisonment of three calendar years and to pay a fine of
11 fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000).

12 "b. Is 500 grams or more, but less than one kilo,
13 the person shall be sentenced to a mandatory minimum term of
14 imprisonment of five calendar years and to pay a fine of one
15 hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000).

16 "c. Is one kilo, but less than 10 kilos, then the
17 person shall be sentenced to a mandatory minimum term of
18 imprisonment of 15 calendar years and to pay a fine of two
19 hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000).

20 "d. Is 10 kilos or more, the person shall be
21 sentenced to a mandatory term of imprisonment of life ~~without~~
22 ~~parole~~.

23 "(8) Any person who knowingly sells, manufactures,
24 delivers, or brings into this state, or who is knowingly in
25 actual or constructive possession of, four grams or more of
26 phencyclidine, or any mixture containing phencyclidine, is

1 guilty of a felony, which felony shall be known as
2 "trafficking in illegal drugs." If the quantity involved:

3 "a. Is four grams or more, but less than 14 grams,
4 the person shall be sentenced to a mandatory minimum term of
5 imprisonment of three calendar years and to pay a fine of
6 fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000).

7 "b. Is 14 grams or more, but less than 28 grams, the
8 person shall be sentenced to a mandatory minimum term of
9 imprisonment of five calendar years and to pay a fine of one
10 hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000).

11 "c. Is 28 grams or more, but less than 56 grams,
12 then the person shall be sentenced to a mandatory minimum term
13 of imprisonment of 15 calendar years and to pay a fine of two
14 hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000).

15 "d. Is 56 grams or more, the person shall be
16 sentenced to a mandatory term of imprisonment of life ~~without~~
17 ~~parole~~.

18 "(9) Any person who knowingly sells, manufactures,
19 delivers, or brings into this state, or who is knowingly in
20 actual or constructive possession of, four grams or more of
21 lysergic acid diethylamide, of four grams or more of any
22 mixture containing lysergic acid diethylamide, is guilty of a
23 felony, which felony shall be known as "trafficking in illegal
24 drugs." If the quantity involved:

25 "a. Is four grams or more, but less than 14 grams,
26 the person shall be sentenced to a mandatory minimum term of

1 imprisonment of three calendar years and to pay a fine of
2 fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000).

3 "b. Is 14 grams or more, but less than 28 grams, the
4 person shall be sentenced to a mandatory minimum term of
5 imprisonment of 10 calendar years and to pay a fine of one
6 hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000).

7 "c. Is 28 grams or more, but less than 56 grams, the
8 person shall be sentenced to a mandatory minimum term of
9 imprisonment of 25 calendar years and to pay a fine of five
10 hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000).

11 "d. Is 56 grams or more, the person shall be
12 sentenced to a mandatory term of imprisonment of life ~~without~~
13 ~~parole~~.

14 "(10) Any person who knowingly sells, manufactures,
15 delivers or brings into this state, or who is knowingly in
16 actual or constructive possession of, 28 grams or more of
17 amphetamine or any mixture containing amphetamine, its salt,
18 optical isomer, or salt of its optical isomer thereof, is
19 guilty of a felony, which felony shall be known as
20 "trafficking in amphetamine." If the quantity involved:

21 "a. Is 28 grams or more but less than 500 grams, the
22 person shall be sentenced to a mandatory minimum term of
23 imprisonment of three calendar years and to pay a fine of
24 fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000).

25 "b. Is 500 grams or more, but less than one kilo,
26 the person shall be sentenced to a mandatory minimum term of

1 imprisonment of five calendar years and to pay a fine of one
2 hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000).

3 "c. Is one kilo but less than 10 kilos, then the
4 person shall be sentenced to a mandatory minimum term of
5 imprisonment of 15 calendar years and to pay a fine of two
6 hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000).

7 "d. Is 10 kilos or more, the person shall be
8 sentenced to a mandatory term of imprisonment of life ~~without~~
9 ~~parole~~.

10 "(11) Any person who knowingly sells, manufactures,
11 delivers, or brings into this state, or who is knowingly in
12 actual or constructive possession of, 28 grams or more of
13 methamphetamine or any mixture containing methamphetamine, its
14 salts, optical isomers, or salt of its optical isomers
15 thereof, is guilty of a felony, which felony shall be known as
16 "trafficking in methamphetamine." If the quantity involved:

17 "a. Is 28 grams or more but less than 500 grams, the
18 person shall be sentenced to a mandatory minimum term of
19 imprisonment of three calendar years and to pay a fine of
20 fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000).

21 "b. Is 500 grams or more, but less than one kilo,
22 the person shall be sentenced to a mandatory minimum term of
23 imprisonment of five calendar years and to pay a fine of one
24 hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000).

25 "c. Is one kilo but less than 10 kilos, then the
26 person shall be sentenced to a mandatory minimum term of

1 imprisonment of 15 calendar years and to pay a fine of two
2 hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000).

3 "d. Is 10 kilos or more, the person shall be
4 sentenced to a mandatory term of imprisonment of life ~~without~~
5 ~~parole~~.

6 "(12) Any person who knowingly sells, manufactures,
7 delivers, or brings into this state, or who is knowingly in
8 actual or constructive possession of 56 or more grams of a
9 synthetic controlled substance or a synthetic controlled
10 substance analogue, as described in subdivision (4) or (5) of
11 subsection (a) of Section 20-2-23, except for any synthetic
12 controlled substance Fentanyl analogue referenced in
13 subdivision (13), is guilty of a felony, which felony shall be
14 known as "trafficking in synthetic controlled substances." If
15 the quantity involved:

16 "a. Is 56 grams or more, but less than 500 grams,
17 the person shall be sentenced to a mandatory minimum term of
18 imprisonment of three calendar years and to pay a fine of
19 fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000).

20 "b. Is 500 grams or more, but less than 1 kilo, the
21 person shall be sentenced to a mandatory minimum term of
22 imprisonment of 10 calendar years and to pay a fine of one
23 hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000).

24 "c. Is one kilo, but less than 10 kilos, then the
25 person shall be sentenced to a mandatory minimum term of
26 imprisonment of 15 calendar years and to pay a fine of two
27 hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000).

1 "d. Is 10 kilos or more, the person shall be
2 sentenced to a mandatory term of imprisonment of life ~~without~~
3 ~~parole~~.

4 "(13) Any person who knowingly sells, manufactures,
5 delivers, or brings into this state, or who is knowingly in
6 actual or constructive possession of, one gram or more of
7 Fentanyl or any synthetic controlled substance Fentanyl
8 analogue, or any mixture containing Fentanyl or any synthetic
9 controlled substance Fentanyl analogue as described in
10 Sections 20-2-23 and 20-2-25, is guilty of a felony, which
11 felony shall be known as "trafficking in illegal drugs." If
12 the quantity involved:

13 "a. Is one gram or more, but less than two grams,
14 the person shall be sentenced to a mandatory minimum term of
15 imprisonment of three calendar years and to pay a fine of
16 fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000).

17 "b. Is two grams or more, but less than four grams,
18 the person shall be sentenced to a mandatory minimum term of
19 imprisonment of 10 calendar years and to pay a fine of one
20 hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000).

21 "c. Is four grams or more, but less than eight
22 grams, the person shall be sentenced to a mandatory minimum
23 term of imprisonment of 25 calendar years and to pay a fine of
24 five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000).

25 "d. Is eight grams or more, the person shall be
26 sentenced to a mandatory term of imprisonment of life.

1 "(14) In lieu of the weight ranges listed in
2 subdivisions (3) and (12), a person may instead be charged
3 with trafficking any substance listed in subdivisions (3) and
4 (12) if that person possesses 50 or more individual packages
5 of that substance. The person shall only be sentenced
6 according to the sentence range provision listed in paragraph
7 a. of each subdivision for the specific substance contained in
8 the 50 or more individual packages if charged pursuant to this
9 subdivision, subdivision (15), or subdivision (16), if
10 applicable. In order to charge a person pursuant to this
11 subdivision, the same substance must be contained in each of
12 the 50 or more individual packages.

13 "~~(13)~~ (15) The felonies of "trafficking in
14 cannabis," "trafficking in cocaine," "trafficking in illegal
15 drugs," "trafficking in amphetamine," "trafficking in
16 methamphetamine," and "trafficking in synthetic controlled
17 substances" as defined in subdivisions (1) through ~~(12)~~ (13),
18 above, shall be treated as Class A felonies for purposes of
19 Title 13A, including sentencing under Section 13A-5-9.
20 Provided, however, that the sentence of imprisonment for a
21 defendant with one or more prior felony convictions who
22 violates subdivisions (1) through ~~(12)~~ (13) of this section
23 shall be the sentence provided therein, or the sentence
24 provided under Section 13A-5-9, whichever is greater. Provided
25 further, that the fine for a defendant with one or more prior
26 felony convictions who violates subdivisions (1) through ~~(12)~~

1 (13) of this section shall be the fine provided therein, or
2 the fine provided under Section 13A-5-9, whichever is greater.

3 "~~(14)~~ (16) Notwithstanding any provision of law to
4 the contrary, any person who has possession of a firearm
5 during the commission of any act proscribed by this section
6 shall be punished by a term of imprisonment of five calendar
7 years which shall be in addition to, and not in lieu of, the
8 punishment otherwise provided, and a fine of twenty-five
9 thousand dollars (\$25,000); the court shall not suspend the
10 five-year additional sentence of the person or give the person
11 a probationary sentence.

12 "§20-2-23.

13 "(a) The Legislature finds the following:

14 "(1) New synthetic substances are being created
15 which are not controlled under the provisions of existing
16 state law but which have a potential for abuse similar to or
17 greater than that for substances controlled under existing
18 state law. These new synthetic substances are called
19 "synthetic controlled substances or synthetic controlled
20 substance analogues" and can be designed to produce a desired
21 pharmacological effect and to evade the controlling statutory
22 provisions. Synthetic controlled substances or synthetic
23 controlled substance analogues are being manufactured,
24 distributed, possessed, and used as substitutes for controlled
25 substances.

26 "(2) The hazards attributable to the traffic in and
27 use of a synthetic controlled substance or synthetic

1 controlled substance analogues are increased because their
2 unregulated manufacture produces variations in purity and
3 concentration.

4 "(3) Many new synthetic substances are untested, and
5 it cannot be immediately determined whether they have useful
6 medical or chemical purposes.

7 "(4) The uncontrolled importation, manufacture,
8 distribution, possession, or use of controlled substance
9 analogues has a substantial and detrimental impact on the
10 health and safety of the people of this state.

11 "(5) Synthetic controlled substances or synthetic
12 controlled substance analogues can be created more rapidly
13 than they can be identified and controlled by action of the
14 Legislature. There is a need for a speedy determination of
15 their proper classification under existing law. It is
16 therefore necessary to identify and classify new substances
17 that have a potential for abuse, so that they can be
18 controlled in the same manner as other substances controlled
19 under existing state law.

20 "(b) The controlled substances listed in this
21 section are included in Schedule I:

22 "(1) Any of the following opiates, including their
23 isomers, esters, ethers, salts, and salts of isomers, esters
24 and ethers, unless specifically excepted, whenever the
25 existence of these isomers, esters, ethers and salts is
26 possible within the specific chemical designation:

27 "a. Acetylmethadol;

1 "b. Allylprodine;
2 "c. Alphacetylmethadol;
3 "d. Alphameprodine;
4 "e. Alphamethadol;
5 "f. Benzethidine;
6 "g. Betacetylmethadol;
7 "h. Betameprodine;
8 "i. Betamethadol;
9 "j. Betaprodine;
10 "k. Clonitazene;
11 "l. Dextromoramide;
12 "m. Dextrorphan;
13 "n. Diampromide;
14 "o. Diethylthiambutene;
15 "p. Dimenoxadol;

18 "s. Dioxaphetyl butyrate;
19 "t. Dipipanone;
20 "u. Ethylmethylthiambutene;

14 Schedule I or Schedule II and the substance is actually
15 capable of producing a stimulant, depressant, or
16 hallucinogenic effect on the central nervous system that
17 mimics, is similar to, or is greater than the stimulant,
18 depressant, or hallucinogenic effect on the central nervous
19 system of a controlled substance in Schedule I or Schedule II.

8 substituted in the (either) phenyl ring to any extent.

9 "21. Any compound structurally related to
10 a-pyrrolidinopentiophenone (a-pvp) whether or not further
11 substituted in the phenyl ring to any extent, whether or not
12 further substituted in the pyrrolidine ring to any extent.

13 "b. A synthetic controlled substance or analogue in
14 subdivision (4) or this subdivision does not include any of
15 the following:

16 "1. Any substance for which there is an approved new
17 drug application under the Federal Food, Drug, and Cosmetic
18 Act.

19 "2. With respect to a particular person, any
20 substance, if an exemption is in effect for investigational
21 use, for that person, as provided by 21 U.S.C. § 355, and the
22 person is registered as a controlled substance researcher as
23 required under section 152.12, subdivision 3, to the extent
24 conduct with respect to the substance is pursuant to the
25 exemption and registration.

26 "c. A controlled substance analogue is treated as a
27 controlled substance in Schedule I.

1 "d. After the Alabama Department of Forensic
2 Sciences has determined a substance to be a synthetic
3 controlled substance analogue under this section, the
4 department shall notify the Alabama Department of Public
5 Health with information relevant to scheduling as provided by
6 Section 20-2-20."

7 Section 2. The amendatory language in this act shall
8 only apply to offenses occurring on or after the effective
9 date of this act and shall not apply retroactively.

10 Section 3. Although this bill would have as its
11 purpose or effect the requirement of a new or increased
12 expenditure of local funds, the bill is excluded from further
13 requirements and application under Amendment 621, now
14 appearing as Section 111.05 of the Official Recompilation of
15 the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended, because the
16 bill defines a new crime or amends the definition of an
17 existing crime.

18 Section 4. This act shall become effective
19 immediately following its passage and approval by the
20 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
