8 NAMING A PORTION OF HIGHWAY 31 NORTH IN AUTAUGA  
9 COUNTY THE SERGEANT WILLIAM "TROY" SEAMON MEMORIAL HIGHWAY.

11 WHEREAS, William "Troy" Seamon graduated from  
12 Marbury High School in 1992; and

13 WHEREAS, Sergeant Seamon joined the Pine Level  
14 Volunteer Fire Department October 1990 and served until he was  
15 inducted as an Honorary Life Member in 2000; and

16 WHEREAS, Sergeant Seamon was initiated as a Mason of  
17 the Prattville Masonic Lodge 89, August 28, 2006; and

18 WHEREAS, Sergeant Seamon loved politics and was a  
19 member of the Autauga County Republican Party, where he was  
20 elected and served as an Executive Committee Member; and

21 WHEREAS, His love for radio communication led  
22 Sergeant Seamon into amateur radio; he received his Amateur  
23 Radio License December 15, 2011, with the call sign KK4CPZ,  
24 and after receiving his general license on January 4, 2012, he  
25 changed his call sign to W4ASO; and

26 WHEREAS, Sergeant Seamon began his career in law  
27 enforcement with the Autauga County Sheriff's Office as part

1 of the reserve deputy program in November 1995, and he was  
2 hired for the patrol division July 6, 1998, before graduating  
3 from the South West Alabama Police Academy, October 14, 1998;  
4 and

5 WHEREAS, Sergeant Seamon was transferred into  
6 Investigations and took over the Sex Offender Registration in  
7 2006; later he was promoted to the rank of Sergeant on April  
8 19, 2011; and

9 WHEREAS, Sergeant Seamon facilitated the  
10 installation of new telephone and computer systems throughout  
11 the courthouse, sheriff's office, and commission building  
12 where he worked countless hours on and off duty to maintain  
13 those systems; and

14 WHEREAS, Sergeant Seamon facilitated the  
15 installation and maintained the updated radio systems for  
16 communication between dispatch and deputies; and

17 WHEREAS, Sergeant Seamon was a perfectionist and  
18 wanted everything in the Sheriff's Office to look  
19 professional; he was instrumental in designing the Sheriff's  
20 Office Patch and demanded that the patch include the flag; and

21 WHEREAS, Sergeant William "Troy" Seamon's untimely  
22 death occurred on April 4, 2016; and

23 WHEREAS, while no action on our part can make amends  
24 to his family and friends for their loss, this special  
25 designation may ensure that he is constantly remembered with  
26 utmost gratitude; now therefore,

1                   BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH  
2           HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That in honor of Sergeant William  
3           "Troy" Seamon, we declare that a portion of U.S. Highway 31 N  
4           in Autauga County, beginning at 2251 Highway 31 North to the  
5           Liberty Baptist Church located on Highway 31 N, be named the  
6           Sergeant William "Troy" Seamon Memorial Highway.

7                   BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the appropriate  
8           officials be requested to place and maintain signs or markers  
9           as provided in this resolution.
