14 the National Indian Gaming Commission pursuant to the Indian  
15 Gaming Regulatory Act and which is operated by any Native  
16 American tribe in Alabama"

17  
18 On page 2, delete lines 24 through 27 in their  
19 entirety, and insert in lieu thereof the following:  
20 any electronic machine.

22 On page 3, line 1, delete "tribe in Alabama."

23  
24 On page 3, after line 6, insert the following:

25 (c) For purposes of this amendment, bingo means a  
26 specific kind of game of chance commonly known as bingo,  
27 whether or not played using paper or on a computer or using

1 electronic or technological aids in connection therewith, in  
2 which prizes are awarded on the basis of designated numbers or  
3 symbols on a card conforming to numbers or symbols selected at  
4 random. The game of bingo may be played on any machine or  
5 device, electronic or otherwise. Sections 8-1-150, 13A-12-20  
6 through 13A-12-30 of the Code of Alabama 1975, do not apply to  
7 any bingo games authorized by this amendment and operated in  
8 accordance with the rules adopted by the Macon County Sheriff.

10 On page 3, lines 22 through 24, delete "that is  
11 authorized by the National Indian Gaming Commission pursuant  
12 to the Indian Gaming Regulatory Act and is operated by any  
13 Native American tribe in Alabama"
