13 Relating to Class 2 municipalities; to amend Section
14 32-13-6, Code of Alabama 1975, to provide that any Class 2
15 municipality that owns and operates an impound facility and
16 sells abandoned motor vehicles at public auction shall retain
17 the proceeds from the sale in the general fund of the
18 municipality.

19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

20 Section 1. Section 32-13-6, Code of Alabama 1975, is
21 amended to read as follows:

22 "§32-13-6.

23 "A person or entity~~r~~ making the sale of the motor
24 vehicle shall deduct from the proceeds of the sale the
25 reasonable cost of repair, towing, storage, and all reasonable
26 expenses incurred in connection with the sale. The person or
27 entity shall also pay the balance remaining to the license

1 plate issuing official of the county in which ~~such~~ the sale is
2 made to be distributed to the general fund of the county,
3 except any Class 2 municipality that owns and operates an
4 impound facility and sells the motor vehicles at public
5 auction, the proceeds from the sale shall be retained by the
6 municipality and deposited into the general fund of the
7 municipality; provided, that ~~such~~ the costs shall in no event
8 exceed the customary charges for like services in the
9 community where the sale is made."

10 Section 2. This act shall become effective
11 immediately following its passage and approval by the
12 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
