8 SYNOPSIS: Under existing law, the Polygraph Examiners
9 Board is responsible for the regulation and
10 licensing of polygraph examiners in the state.

11 This bill would increase application,
12 original license, and license renewal fees for
13 polygraph examiners.

17 AN ACT

19 To amend Section 34-25-26, Code of Alabama 1975,
20 relating to the Polygraph Examiners Board; to increase
21 application, original license, and license renewal fees for
22 polygraph examiners.

23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

24 Section 1. Section 34-25-26 of the Code of Alabama
25 1975, is amended to read as follows:

26 "§34-25-26.

1 "The fee requirements of this chapter shall apply to
2 all polygraph examiners, including those employed by
3 governmental agencies, and to those who engage in polygraph
4 examinations on any commercial basis. The fees to be paid,
5 effective ~~October 1, 1991~~ October 1, 2019, are as follows:

6 "(1) By an applicant for an examination to determine
7 his or her fitness to receive a polygraph examiner's license
8 is ~~\$150~~ two hundred fifty dollars (\$250), which is not to be
9 credited as payment against the license fee and is not
10 refundable~~.~~.

11 "(2) For the issuance of an original polygraph
12 examiner's license the fee is ~~\$100~~, two hundred fifty dollars
13 (\$250).

14 "(3) For the issuance of an internship license the
15 fee is ~~\$100~~, one hundred dollars (\$100).

16 "(4) For the issuance of a duplicate polygraph
17 examiner's license the fee is ~~\$20~~, twenty dollars (\$20).

18 "(5) For the issuance of a polygraph examiner's
19 renewal license the fee is ~~\$100~~, two hundred dollars (\$200).

20 "(6) For the extension or renewal of an internship
21 license the fee is ~~\$100~~, and one hundred dollars (\$100).

22 "(7) For the issuance of a duplicate internship
23 license the fee is ~~\$20~~ twenty dollars (\$20)."

24 Section 2. This act shall become effective on the
25 first day of the third month following its passage and
26 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
