10 TO BE ENTITLED  
11 AN ACT

13 Relating to Cullman County; to amend Section 11 of  
14 Act 81-599 of the 1981 Regular Session (Acts 1981, p. 1002),  
15 relating to the distribution of the 1981 sales and use tax; to  
16 further provide for a portion of the distribution of the  
17 proceeds to the Cullman County Fire Association Training  
18 Center.

19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

20 Section 1. Section 11 of Act 81-599 of the 1981  
21 Regular Session (Acts 1981, p. 1002), is amended to read as  
22 follows:

23 "Section 11. The proceeds of any taxes herein  
24 authorized to be levied shall be distributed as follows:

25 "(1) 45 percent to the general fund of the City of  
26 Cullman7.

1           "(2) 15 percent to the general fund of Cullman  
2 County to be used by the County Commission~~7~~.

3           "(3) 15 percent to the Cullman County Commission to  
4 the credit of the road fund~~7~~.

5           "(4) 10 percent to the Cullman County Commission for  
6 use by the Cullman County Board of Education~~7~~.

7           "(5) 10 percent to the municipalities of Cullman  
8 County, ~~except Cullman,~~ to be distributed on a population  
9 basis~~7~~ ~~and~~.

10           "(6) ~~5~~ a. Five percent to the rural volunteer fire  
11 departments of the county, to be equally distributed among the  
12 following volunteer fire departments in Cullman County:  
13 Arkadelphia, Baileyton, Battle Ground, Berlin, Bethsadia,  
14 Bremen, Cold Springs, Crane Hill, Dodge City, Fairview, Garden  
15 City, Gold Ridge, Good Hope, Holly Pond, Johnson Crossing,  
16 Jones Chapel, Joppa, Logan, Loretto, Providence, Sardis,  
17 Trimble, Walter, and West Point.

18           "b. The Hanceville Fire Department and the Cullman  
19 County Fire Association Training Center shall also receive a  
20 share of ~~such~~ the proceeds equal to that received by each ~~said~~  
21 volunteer fire department. Additionally, ~~volunteer fire~~  
22 departments may be designated to receive funds hereunder by  
23 resolution of the Cullman County Commission upon the  
24 recommendation of the Cullman County Volunteer Fire Department  
25 Association and the Cullman office of the Alabama Forestry  
26 Commission."

1                   Section 2. This act shall become effective on the  
2 first day of the third month following its passage and  
3 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
