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9 A BILL  
10 TO BE ENTITLED  
11 AN ACT  
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13 To authorize the City Council of the City of  
14 Hueytown, Alabama, pursuant to Amendment 373 to the  
15 Constitution of Alabama of 1901, now appearing as Section 217  
16 of the Official ReCompilation of the Constitution of Alabama  
17 of 1901, as amended, to increase the rate at which there is  
18 levied and collected by the city on all taxable property  
19 situated within the city the ad valorem tax authorized in the  
20 Constitution, to a maximum rate for any tax year of the city,  
21 which is equal to \$20 on each one thousand dollars (20 mills  
22 on each thousand dollars) of assessed value.

23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

24 Section 1. The following words shall have the  
25 following meanings:

26 (1) AMENDMENT 373. The amendment to the Constitution  
27 of Alabama 1901, that was proposed by Act 6, H. 170, 1978

1 Second Special Session, now appearing as Section 217 of the  
2 Official Recompilation of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901,  
3 as amended.

4 (2) CITY TAX. The ad valorem tax authorized in the  
5 Constitution of Alabama of 1901, and levied and collected on  
6 taxable property in the City Hueytown, Alabama, was originally  
7 levied at the rate of 5 mills on each one thousand dollars of  
8 assessed value and, presently levied at the rate of 10 mills  
9 on each thousand dollars of assessed value.

10 Section 2. The City of Hueytown, Alabama, presently  
11 levies and collects the city tax at a rate of ten dollars  
12 (\$10) on each one thousand dollars (10 mills on each thousand  
13 dollars) of assessed value. Pursuant to a resolution adopted  
14 by the City Council of the City of Hueytown, Alabama, in  
15 accordance with Amendment 373, the City of Hueytown, Alabama,  
16 proposes to increase by 10 mills the rate at which it may levy  
17 and collect the city tax to a maximum rate, for any tax year,  
18 which is equal to twenty dollars (\$20) on each thousand  
19 dollars (\$1,000) (20 mills on each thousand dollars) of  
20 assessed value.

21 Section 3. Pursuant to subsection (f) of Amendment  
22 373, the City Council of the City of Hueytown, Alabama, may  
23 increase the rate at which the City of Hueytown, Alabama,  
24 levies and collects the city tax to a maximum rate for any tax  
25 year which is equal to twenty dollars (\$20) on each one  
26 thousand dollars (\$1,000) (20 mills on each thousand dollars)  
27 of assessed value, the increase of 10 mills on each dollar of

1        assessed value to be used as follows: The net proceeds related  
2        to the 10 mills shall be used for general municipal purposes.

3                Section 4. The increase in the rate at which the  
4        city tax may be levied and collected pursuant to this act is  
5        subject to the approval of a majority of the qualified  
6        electors residing in the City of Hueytown, Alabama, who vote  
7        on the proposed increase at a special election called and held  
8        for that purpose pursuant to subsection (f) of Amendment 373.

9                Section 5. This act shall become effective  
10       immediately following its passage and approval by the  
11       Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
