2 ENROLLED, An Act,

3 Relating to trade schools and junior colleges; to
4 require trade schools or junior colleges that offer certain
5 truck driving courses to offer training on the recognition,
6 prevention, and reporting of human trafficking; and to require
7 private driver training schools to use best efforts to
8 incorporate in the course curriculum the specific training on
9 the recognition, prevention, and reporting of human
10 trafficking.

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

12 Section 1. (a) Any trade school or junior college,
13 as defined in Section 16-60-81, Code of Alabama 1975, offering
14 instruction in the operation of commercial motor vehicles as
15 part of the driver training school shall offer, as part of the
16 commercial motor vehicle driving course curriculum, industry
17 specific training on the recognition, prevention, and
18 reporting of human trafficking.

19 (b) The Board of Trustees of the Alabama Community
20 College System shall be responsible for ensuring the
21 instruction requirements in subsection (a) are met. The board,
22 in conjunction with organizations that specialize in the
23 recognition and prevention of human trafficking, shall
24 annually review and update the training to include changes and
25 trends in human trafficking.

1 (c) Private driver training schools shall use best
2 efforts to incorporate in the course curriculum the specific
3 training on the recognition, prevention, and reporting of
4 human trafficking.

5 Section 2. This act shall become effective on
6 January 1, 2020, following its passage and approval by the
7 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
