3 (b) (1) The Battleground School Historical Board may
4 accept title to the former Battleground School property owned
5 by the Cullman County Board of Education and may hold the
6 property for the benefit and use of the public, particularly
7 the unincorporated community of Battleground. The Battleground
8 School Historical Board may receive state, local, and other
9 governmental funding and may accept charitable donations.

10 (2) The board may not sell or transfer ownership of
11 the property unless approved by majority vote of the board and
12 then by a majority vote of the qualified electors in the
13 unincorporated community of Battleground at a referendum
14 called by the judge of probate and held during the following
15 general election.

16 (c) The Battleground School Historical Board may be
17 reorganized as an unincorporated nonprofit association or
18 other entity authorized by law by unanimous consent of the
19 board.

20 Section 2. This act shall become effective
21 immediately following its passage and approval by the
22 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
