2 ENROLLED, An Act,

3 Relating to Talladega County; to amend Section 3 of  
4 Act 90-430, 1990 Regular Session (Acts 1990, p. 593), as  
5 amended by Act 2002-283, 2002 Regular Session (Acts 2002, p.  
6 595) and Act 2005-139, 2005 Regular Session (Acts 2005, p.  
7 243), providing for the establishment of and distribution of  
8 funds from the Law Library Fund and the Juvenile Justice Fund;  
9 to dissolve the Juvenile Justice Fund Committee and to further  
10 provide for the expenditures from the Law Library Fund and the  
11 Juvenile Justice Fund.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

13 Section 1. Section 3 of Act 90-430, 1990 Regular  
14 Session (Acts 1990, p. 593), as amended by Act 2002-283, 2002  
15 Regular Session (Acts 2002, p. 595) and Act 2005-139, 2005  
16 Regular Session (Acts 2005, p. 243), is amended to read as  
17 follows:

18 "Section 3. The county shall expend monies from the  
19 two funds herein created as follows:

20 "(a) From the Law Library Fund, only expenditures  
21 for the purchase and maintenance of books, reports,  
22 periodicals, and operations shall be authorized as directed by  
23 the presiding circuit court judge of Talladega County.

24 "(b) From the Juvenile Justice Fund, only those  
25 expenditures authorized and directed by the ~~Juvenile Justice~~

1 ~~Fund Committee, consisting of the presiding circuit court~~  
2 ~~judge, the district attorney, the sheriff, the chair of the~~  
3 ~~county commission, the Director of the Talladega Department of~~  
4 ~~Human Resources, the juvenile court judge, and the circuit~~  
5 ~~clerk, presiding juvenile court judge for any juvenile justice~~  
6 or enforcement purposes.

7           "(c) Notwithstanding subsections (a) and (b),  
8 immediately upon the effective date of the act ~~adding~~ amending  
9 this subsection, funds in the Law Library Fund ~~shall~~ may be  
10 used to pay the remainder of salaries of court attendants and  
11 funds in the Juvenile Justice Fund ~~shall~~ may be used to pay  
12 the salaries of juvenile court specialists until the positions  
13 are funded from other court funds at the same level as the  
14 positions were funded in the 2002-2003 fiscal year, at which  
15 time this subsection shall be ineffective."

16           Section 2. This act shall become effective  
17 immediately following its passage and approval by the  
18 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
