10 TO BE ENTITLED
11 AN ACT
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13 Relating to Shelby County; to further provide for
14 the salary of the Shelby County Property Tax Commissioner by
15 converting an existing expense allowance to salary commencing
16 on the next term of office; to specify that the property tax
17 commissioner would continue to receive the same cost-of-living
18 increases granted to other county officials and to ratify and
19 confirm any cost-of-living increases granted prior to the
20 effective date of this act; and to repeal Act 2006-240 of the
21 2006 Regular Session effective beginning the next term of
22 office of the property tax commissioner.

23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

24 Section 1. (a) Effective commencing on the next term
25 of office beginning on October 1, 2021, the expense allowance
26 granted to the Shelby County Property Tax Commissioner in the
27 amount of six hundred dollars (\$600) per month pursuant to Act

1 2006-240, 2006 Regular Session shall be converted to salary,
2 and the expense allowance shall be null and void and shall be
3 repealed.

4 (b) In addition to any other salary granted to the
5 Shelby County Property Tax Commissioner, the Shelby County
6 Property Tax Commissioner shall be entitled to receive any
7 uniform increases in compensation whether in the form of
8 cost-of-living raises or otherwise granted to any county
9 official of Shelby County, and any cost-of-living increases or
10 other uniform increases granted to the property tax
11 commissioner prior to the effective date of this act are
12 ratified and confirmed.

13 Section 2. Effective commencing on the beginning of
14 the next term of office of the Shelby County Property Tax
15 Commissioner, Act 2006-240 of the 2006 Regular Session is
16 repealed.

17 Section 3. This act shall become effective
18 immediately following its passage and approval by the
19 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
