2 ENROLLED, An Act,

3           Relating to Marshall County; providing for the  
4 budgetary operations within the office of the revenue  
5 commissioner; providing that the office would be financed on a  
6 pro rata share basis from proceeds of ad valorem taxes  
7 collected by the revenue commissioner; and providing for  
8 supplemental effect.

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

10           Section 1. The Revenue Commissioner of Marshall  
11 County shall be responsible for the budgetary operations and  
12 functions of his or her office. The expenses of the office  
13 shall be financed on a pro rata share basis from the proceeds  
14 of ad valorem taxes collected in the office. Any funds  
15 retained by the office pursuant to this act shall be used  
16 solely for the operation of the Office of Revenue Commissioner  
17 subject to approval of the budget for the office by the county  
18 commission in the same manner as the budget is currently  
19 approved.

20           Section 2. The provisions of this act are  
21 supplemental. It shall be construed in pari materia with other  
22 laws relating to the Office of the Revenue Commissioner of  
23 Marshall County; however, those laws or parts of laws which  
24 are in direct conflict or inconsistent with this act are  
25 repealed.

1                   Section 3. This act shall become effective  
2 immediately following its passage and approval by the  
3 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
