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9 A BILL  
10 TO BE ENTITLED  
11 AN ACT  
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13 Relating to Montgomery County, Alabama, and  
14 particularly to the Pike Road School Tax District (the area  
15 within the City of Pike Road, Alabama) in said County; to  
16 provide for the levy in said District of an additional 25.5  
17 mills of ad valorem school district taxation effective  
18 simultaneously with the expiration of 6.5 mills of a separate  
19 ad valorem school district tax, so as to produce a net  
20 increase of 19 mills of ad valorem school district taxation in  
21 said District, subject to approval of the levy of said  
22 additional school district taxation by a majority of the  
23 qualified electors of said District voting at a special  
24 election to be held in said District therefor pursuant to the  
25 laws governing special elections.

26 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

27 Section 1. For purposes hereof:

1                   (1) Additional Pike Road School District Taxation  
2 means the levy and collection in the Pike Road School Tax  
3 District of additional ad valorem school district taxation at  
4 the uniform rate of 3 mills pursuant to Amendment No. 3 to the  
5 Alabama Constitution, as increased by 22.5 mills pursuant to  
6 Section 217 of the Alabama Constitution to a uniform total  
7 rate of 25.5 mills, effective simultaneously with the  
8 reduction of 6.5 mills of ad valorem school district taxation  
9 in said District (by expiration of a separate ad valorem  
10 school tax therein) so as to produce a net increase of 19  
11 mills of ad valorem school district taxation in said District,  
12 and for any tax year for which the levy of said additional  
13 school district tax at said uniform total rate shall be  
14 approved in the manner then provided by law.

15                   (2) Alabama Constitution means the Constitution of  
16 Alabama of 1901, as amended.

17                   (3) Favorable Majority Vote means the approval of  
18 the Additional Pike Road School District Taxation by a  
19 majority of the qualified electors of the Pike Road School Tax  
20 District who vote at a special election to be held in the Pike  
21 Road School Tax District therefor pursuant to the laws  
22 governing special elections.

23                   (4) Pike Road School Tax District means and includes  
24 the area within the corporate limits of the City of Pike Road,  
25 Alabama.

26                   (5) Proposal of Taxing Authority means the proposal  
27 of the Additional Pike Road School District Taxation by the

1 Montgomery County Commission, as the taxing authority with  
2 respect thereto, by resolution and order adopted upon request  
3 of the City Board of Education of the City of Pike Road,  
4 Alabama.

5 Section 2. The Legislature of Alabama, for purposes  
6 of Section 217 of the Alabama Constitution and upon adoption  
7 of the Proposal of the Taxing Authority, approves the  
8 Additional Pike Road School District Taxation subject to the  
9 Favorable Majority Vote.

10 Section 3. The provisions of this act are severable.  
11 If any part of this act is declared invalid or  
12 unconstitutional, such declaration will not operate or be  
13 construed to affect the validity or constitutionality of any  
14 other part or provision hereof.

15 Section 4. This act shall become effective  
16 immediately upon its passage and approval by the Governor, or  
17 upon its otherwise becoming law.
