15 Section 2. On or after the effective date of this
16 act, an individual performing the duties of a public safety
17 telecommunicator, as defined in Section 11-98-1, Code of
18 Alabama 1975, and employed by a primary PSAP receiving 911
19 calls, shall be certified under rules established by the
20 Statewide 911 Board. Individuals hired on or after the
21 effective date of this act shall have 180 days to be enrolled
22 in the certification process, but shall be allowed to perform
23 the duties of a public safety telecommunicator without
24 certification until the expiration of the 180-day period. Any
25 individual performing the duties of public safety
26 telecommunicator for a primary PSAP receiving 911 calls on or
27 before June 30, 2022, shall not be required to complete the

1 coursework to be certified under rules established by the
2 board.
