3 "(2) Upon the application in writing of any eight
4 members of the board, the Governor shall call a special
5 meeting, naming the time and place thereof and causing notices
6 to be issued in writing to the several members of the board.
7 ~~Such Special~~ meetings shall not be held on a date less than 10
8 days subsequent to the notice from the Governor.

9 "(b) (1) Members of the board may participate in a
10 meeting of the board or any committee of the board by
11 telephone conference, video conference, or similar
12 communications equipment by means of which all persons
13 participating in the meeting may hear each other at the same
14 time. Participation by these means shall constitute presence
15 in person at the meeting for all purposes. However, a majority
16 of a quorum of the members of the board, or, in the event of a
17 meeting of only the executive committee, a majority of a
18 quorum of the executive committee of the board shall be
19 physically present at the location noticed and called for the
20 meeting in order to conduct any business or deliberation.

21 "(2) Members of the board and any committees of the
22 board may not utilize electronic communications except as in
23 compliance with the Alabama Open Meetings Act. ~~Except for~~
24 emergency meetings, notice Notice of board meetings shall be
25 provided in accordance with the Alabama Open Meetings Act and
26 telephone or video conference or similar communications
27 equipment shall also allow members of the public the

1 opportunity to simultaneously listen to or observe the
2 meetings.

3 "(c) The executive committee of the board and other
4 committees of the board shall hold meetings at ~~such~~ times and
5 on ~~such~~ dates as the board of trustees may provide."

6 Section 2. This act shall become effective on the
7 first day of the third month following its passage and
8 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
