4 ENROLLED, An Act,

5 Relating to public K-12 education; to establish a  
6 program of advance enrollment for children of military  
7 families.

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

9 Section 1. A student who is not a domiciliary of the  
10 state shall be permitted to register to enroll in a public  
11 K-12 school by remote means, including electronic means, prior  
12 to commencement of the student's residency in this state if  
13 all of the following apply:

14 (1) A parent or legal guardian is on active military  
15 duty and is transferred or pending transfer to a military  
16 installation or reservation in this state.

17 (2) Upon request by the local board of education, a  
18 parent or legal guardian provides a copy of the official  
19 military order transferring to a military installation or  
20 reservation located in this state.

21 (3) A parent or legal guardian completes and submits  
22 the board of education's required enrollment forms and  
23 documentation, except that proof of residency shall not be  
24 required until the student physically transfers to this state,

1 at which time the student shall be required to provide proof  
2 of residency prior to commencing attendance.

3 (4) The local board of education shall make  
4 available to a student who registers to enroll pursuant to  
5 this section the same opportunities for school assignment and  
6 selection of courses and sporting activities as those offered  
7 to resident students.

8 Section 2. This act shall become effective on the  
9 first day of the third month following its passage and  
10 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
